

## Parent Council Meeting - Feedback on School Development Plan and Budget

The following feedback was collected anonymously on **Wednesday, March 4<sup>th</sup>** from parents in attendance.

### Part 1 – Feedback on School Development Plan and Budget:

1. We share SDP information and updates in different ways. In what ways have you learned about our SDP?

**Participants indicated that they learned about the SDP through school council meetings and school messenger.**

2. The SDP is developed with all students in mind. Do you agree that:

  - The school fees you pay are reasonable considering the benefit they provide your child? **1 participant believed the fees seemed low; 5 participants believed the fees were reasonable**
